Austin Park/Chimneystone Drainage **Improvements**

HISTORY

The 2017 Drainage Study recommended construction of a new drainage channel adjacent to Chimneystone with new inlets and storm sewer improvements and to enlarge the Acacia Stormwater Trunk Line to address structural flooding during major storm events. The 2017 Drainage Study addresses structural flooding of 74 homes during Hurricane Harvey in the Austin Park and Chimneystone neighborhoods.

COST

\$16,500,000

DESCRIPTION


Design and construction of a new drainage channel from just south of State Highway 6 to Acacia and the outfall of Ditch A. Improvements include portion of Austin Parkway reconstruction.

This project will reduce flooding in the Austin Park and Chimneystone neighborhoods during major storm events and provide relief to adjacent storm sewer systems.
