Telfair Drainage Improvements - New Territory and Chatham

HISTORY

The 2017 Drainage Study identified improvements to reduce street ponding along the intersection of New Territory Boulevard and Chatham Avenue.

COST

\$3,000,000

DESCRIPTION

Reconstruction of the existing drainage system to reduce street ponding depths and durations during major storm events at the intersection of New Territory Boulevard and Chatham Avenue. The project will also improve ingress and egress to Fire Station No. 7.

Design and Construction


